

Monitoring Plan Objectives

AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

Objectives approved March 26, 2019 Steering Committee Meeting

Objective 1	Increase air quality awareness in the community by making information easily accessible to the public and easy to understand
Objective 2	Monitor for traffic related air pollutants (criteria & toxics). Determine the spatial distribution of pollution from traffic on Highway 99, and whether these emissions are significant at schools and hospitals
Objective 3	Determine air quality at sensitive receptor locations, and whether air quality changes by season and locations for these sensitive group locations
Objective 4	Determine which source categories the emissions are coming from, and whether the emissions from the sources contribute significantly to poor air quality in nearby areas




