












## Average Black Carbon Concentrations by Time of Day October 2020-February 2021




- Black Carbon is a part of PM2.5







Official Steering Committee meetings will be on a quarterly basis through June 2022.




 District staff will be available in between quarterly meetings to answer any questions and coordinate with subgroup(s).
