Candidates should have strong project management, technical grant writing and project budget management skills. The Air Quality Engineer is responsible for outlining the requirements for contracts, agreements and Memoranda of Understanding; for analysis of potential grant opportunities and budget analyses; and be able to create presentations explaining these analyses and program implementation strategies. Additional responsibilities include collaboration work/meetings with partner agencies, the CA Air Resources Board, Sacramento Clean Cities Coalition, community organizations, school districts, and other constituents.

Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications for the Air Quality Engineer position as outlined in the "SAC Metro Air District Classification" for Air Quality Engineer.
