

# Proposition 1B: Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program Sacramento Metropolitan AQMD Funding Application Public Workshop Notice

The Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District would like to invite you to attend a public workshop to announce the new funding available under our Proposition 1B: Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program. Approximately \$13 million will be available for commercial heavy-duty diesel fleets and railroads in the Sacramento region to fund the replacement of diesel vehicles and equipment used in California goods movement activity., including the following options:

- Replacement of older on-road heavy-duty (Class 6-8 Model Year 2009 & older) diesel vehicles in compliant Small Fleets
- Replacement of on-road heavy-duty diesel vehicles with new natural gas, hybrid, or zero emission replacement vehicles in all compliant truck fleets
- Replacement of older diesel freight locomotives with new clean diesel technology
- Zero emission transport refrigeration unit technology

We will begin accepting truck applications on 9/24/2015. Our solicitation will close at 4:00 PM on 11/20/2015. Application materials and workshop documentation will be made available on our Goods Movement website located at:
