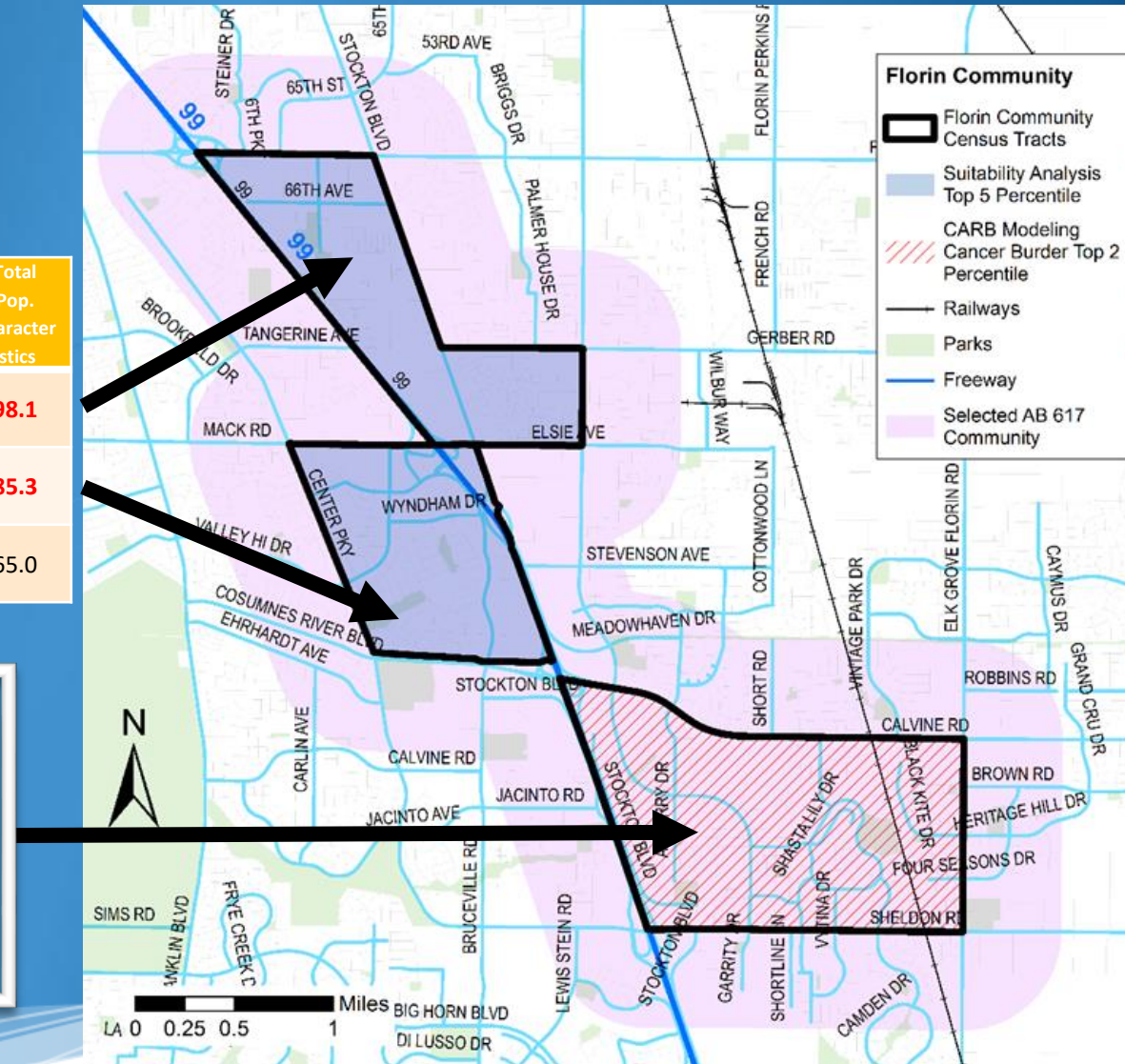

8. Determine monitoring areas.
9. Develop quality control procedures.
10. Describe data management.
11. Provide work plan for conducting field measurements.

HOW WILL DATA BE USED TO TAKE ACTION?

12. Specify process for evaluating effectiveness.
13. Analyze and interpret data.
14. Communicate results to support action.
