Award of FY 2009-10 Funds-Prop 1B Goods Movement	ARB staff will present to the Board for adoption a list of grant awards totaling up to \$200 million in incentive funding. The funding is for specific local agency projects to reduce freight-related emissions in the four trade corridors.		
Proposed AB 118 Air Quality Improvement Program Funding Plan for Fiscal Year 2010-11	ARB staff will present to the Board for adoption the proposed AB 118 Air Quality Improvement Program (AQIP) Funding Plan for Fiscal Year 2010-11. The proposal will include continued funding, with some modifications, to projects funded in the FY 2009-10 AQIP Funding Plan, and funding for several demonstration project categories, including off-road equipment, on-road projects, marine vessels, and locomotives.		
Amendments to the Commercial Harbor Craft Airborne Toxic Control Measure	ARB staff will propose amendments to the Commercial Harbor Craft Airborne Toxic Control Measure to require the diesel-fueled engines on crew and supply, barge, and dredge vessels be subject to in-use engine requirements to reduce diesel PM and NOx emissions.

SB 375 Draft Targets	ARB staff will present draft passenger vehicle greenhouse gas emission reduction targets for the 18 metropolitan planning organizations in California as required by Senate Bill 375. ARB is required by statute to finalize the targets by September 30, 2010.		
Enhanced Vapor Recovery Regulation Amendments Workshop	ARB staff will hold a second public workshop to discuss draft amendments to the Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) regulations.
