# SECAT Successes

- \$67 million spent since 2000
- Over 2100 trucks
- 2700 tons of NO<sub>x</sub>  
200 tons of DPM
- Local health savings of over \$260 million
- Funded with federal CMAQ \$\$\$



# Current Status

- SECAT is oversubscribed for funding
- 1<sup>st</sup> Half of SECAT funding in contracting phase
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Half of SECAT funding waiting on federal funding request
- First come, first served process with many projects being rejected due to noncompliance or lack of funding
- Currently not accepting new applications

# Future Funding



- SECAT expected to receive federal funding through 2018
- Funding must be surplus to regulations
- Future funding will be similar to GMERP
- RFP/Bid process for limited funding
- Less funding per vehicle approaching compliance deadlines
