

Request for Authority to Construct Expiration Extension

Pursuant to Rule 201, section 301, an Authority to Construct shall expire 2 years from the date of issuance. Prior to expiration and if requested in writing, an extension to the Authority to Construct may be granted for up to two years if the Air Pollution Control Officer determines that (1) a good faith effort to complete the project has been made, and (2) the parameters of the project remain the same as in the initial application.

The following information is required by any applicant requesting an extension to their Authority to Construct.

- 1) A written request submitted to and received by the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District (SMAQMD) prior to the expiration of the Authority to Construct.
- 2) Detailed explanation of the steps taken to complete the project prior to the Authority to Construct expiration date. Information may include but is not limited to purchase records and/or agreements, commencement of construction at the site, proof of economic downturn preventing the project going forward during the original timeline, etc.
- 3) A project timeline with milestones for completing the project, not to exceed 2 years including any testing and/or reporting requirements.
- 4) Submittals shall be sent to the attention of Dave Grose, Division Manager Stationary Source Division.
