- Serve for two years, with the option to renew

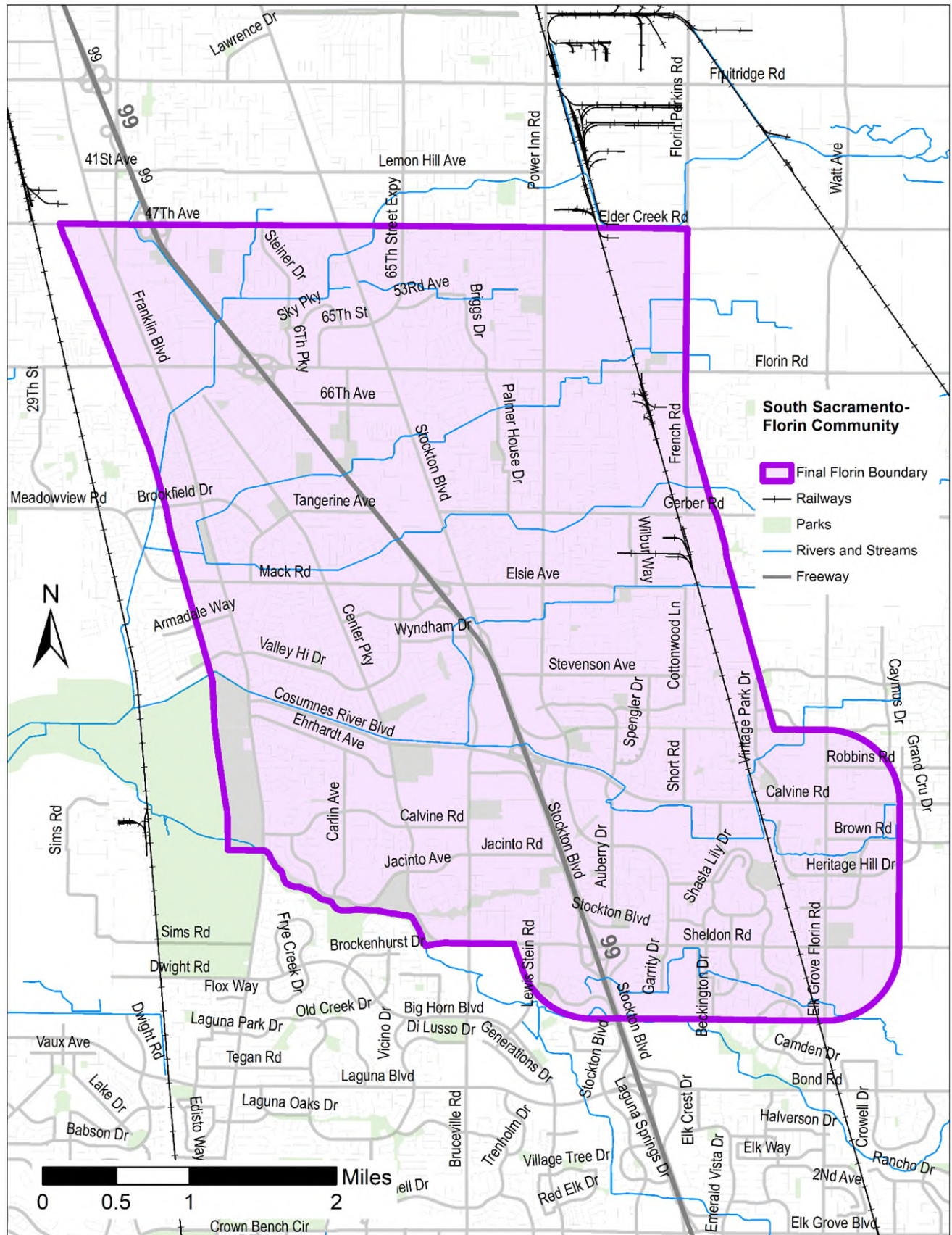
