



## Annual Reporting Permit Condition

On December 15, 2021, the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality District notified all active permit holders that a new Annual Reporting Permit condition had been applied to all permits.

This new condition will only be added to new permits and existing permits that are modified. Otherwise permits will not be retroactively updated at this time. The information in the Annual Report supports local, state, and federal emission reporting mandates.

A copy of the Permit to Operate, including this additional annual reporting requirement condition, must be available at the location of the permitted equipment.

Below is the permit condition language for your reference for maintaining compliance.

### **ANNUAL REPORTING CONDITION**

Unless otherwise directed by SMAQMD, the permit holder must submit their applicable Annual Report to the District by January 31st of every calendar year. The Annual Report forms can be found at [www.airquality.org/AnnualReporting](http://www.airquality.org/AnnualReporting). SMAQMD may require the permit holder to supply additional information under the Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Information and Assessment Act (California Health and Safety Code Section 44300 et seq.) and CARB's Criteria Pollutant and Toxics Emissions Reporting (California Code of Regulations, Title 17, Division 3, Chapter 1, Subchapter 7.7). If additional information is required, the SMAQMD will notify the permit holder.
